



Erna Blanche, Ph.D., OTR/L, FAOTA, received her basic training in occupational therapy at the University of Chile (Santiago, Chile) and later earned her Masters in Special Education at Columbia University. She received a Ph.D. in Occupational Science at USC. She is an expert in pediatric occupational therapy and interventions based on occupational science. She has co-authored two books and one video series on pediatric practice: *Combining Neurodevelopmental Treatment and Sensory Integration Principles, Understanding the Nature of Sensory Integration with Diverse Populations* (book), and *Observations Based on Sensory Integration* (book) and has published numerous articles in English and Spanish on the topics of play and wellness and issues in clinical practice. Her articles have appeared in the *American Journal of Occupational Therapy*, *Occupational Therapy International*, *The Journal of Occupational Science*, and *Play and Culture Studies*, among others, as well as in pediatric textbooks. Dr. Blanche has lectured internationally in more than 20 countries and still has ties with Therapy West, Inc., a clinic seeing over 400 children per week that was co-founded by her, and with the department of occupational therapy at the University of Chile, Santiago, Chile.
