

FUNCTIONAL ACADEMICS

Academic programs are individualized and include functional reading, writing, math, self-help, vocational and community awareness and safety. Work skills are taught in a vocational lab on campus or in the classroom. Speech & Language and Occupational Therapists work closely with teachers in a collaborative model to support students' learning experiences.

COMMUNITY

Students of all ages participate in Community Based Instruction that provides them with opportunities to generalize independent living skills taught in the classroom to real-life experiences such as purchasing items, money management, taking public transportation, and practicing communication skills in the community.

SOCIAL

Social skills instruction is taught and modeled throughout the school day and reinforced through a rich student life that includes art and music programs, recreation club, a community garden, school socials, dances, and holiday celebrations.
